### **ACADEMIC INTEGRITY INTERVENTION PROGRAM**

#### **FOUR – PART INTERVENTION STRATEGY:**

##### **1. Disciplinary Intervention**

- a. XF grade penalty
- b. Probation – requires participation in the following 3 components to remove the X and to re-enroll in the course in which the academic misconduct occurred.

##### **2. Evaluation/Counseling Intervention**

- a. Evaluation – to identify the source of the dishonest behavior
- b. Counseling – to address the source and behavior
- c. Counselor refers the student to the Educational Intervention Seminar

##### **3. Educational Intervention – Two Part Seminar**

###### **Academic Skills Enhancement Seminar**

- a. Academic Integrity Component:
  - What is it and why is it important
- b. Academic Skills Training Component:
  - Time Management
  - Study Skills
  - Test Taking Skills
  - Writing Skills
  - Anxiety Management
  - Goal Setting
- c. Assessment Component

##### **4. Ethics/Ethical Decision Making Seminar**

Case studies, discussions and written work regarding ethics, values, and moral development.

**Successful completion enables the student to petition the Honor Code Council for deletion of the dishonesty notation on the transcript and permission to retake the course.**
