

The Roger LeMoyne Dabbs Memorial Scholarship

The Roger LeMoyne Dabbs Memorial Scholarship (\$1000) was established in 1993 by Elizabeth O. Dabbs. Mr. Dabbs was a graduate of the class of '36 at Mississippi State University.

Qualifications

To qualify for the Dabbs Memorial Scholarship candidates must:

1. be full-time students at Mississippi State University. English majors will be primary candidates. If there are no qualified English majors, then, students majoring in Communication will be considered.
2. have demonstrated academic achievement, a minimum of 3.0 GPA based on a 4.0 system
3. be of good moral character and have demonstrated leadership ability and financial need.

Selection

The scholarship will be awarded on a year to year basis. A student who is the recipient one year is eligible for consideration in any other year; however, the student must again comply with the selection criteria.

Funds will not be given directly to the recipients; rather, the university business office will credit the recipient's tuition and fee expenses each semester.

Deadline

The deadline for applications is March 1.

Please write a short essay (appx. 500 words) describing your academic and extra-curricular or work experiences that you feel demonstrate your moral character and/or your leadership ability.

Also, please have two of your former teachers write letters of support for your application which you will include with your submission.
