

**COURSES MEETING COLLEGE-WIDE REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL STUDENTS
IN THE COLLEGE OF ARTS & SCIENCES**

In order to satisfy College graduation requirements, students seeking B.A., B.S., or B.S.W. degrees must take the number of courses indicated in each of the areas below. By satisfying these College requirements, students will simultaneously satisfy all analogous University Core Requirements.

⇒B.A. and B.S.W. students must complete twelve hours in Humanities and twelve hours in Social Sciences in addition to the two courses in the Humanities and Social Sciences required of all majors. Hence, they must complete a total of 18 hours in the Humanities : (EN, HI, PHI, REL), and 18 hours in the Social Sciences: (AN, GR, PS, PSY, SO).

⇒These additional 24 hours are not limited to the courses listed on this page; they may be satisfied by others in EN, HI, PHI, and REL or in AN, EC, GR, PS, PSY, SO as long as they satisfy the distribution requirements found in the Bulletin.

While all of the courses below satisfy College-wide Requirements, individual departments may require that particular courses in each area be taken to satisfy requirements for their majors.

- PLEASE NOTE: Courses listed on the same line, separated by “or” cannot be taken in combination. Thus, students will not receive credit in Arts & Sciences for two courses which are listed on the same line.
- Honors classes satisfy requirements and students who qualify are encouraged to take the Honors sections.

Basic Skills

English Composition: EN 1103 or 1163 and EN 1113 or 1173.

Public Speaking: CO 1003 or another course approved by major department and approved by the Curriculum Committee as meeting the public speaking requirement. (Air Force ROTC students may substitute AS 3013 and AS 3023) Student must take the course approved by his or her major.

Foreign Language: B.A. degree must show proficiency in 3rd semester FL (FL_ 1113, 1123, and 2133, or equivalent, in one foreign language)

B.S. and B.S.W. degree must show proficiency in 2nd semester FL (FL_ 1113, and 1123, or equivalent, in one foreign language)
