



Scholarship Application

The Mississippi State Chapter of FarmHouse Fraternity is offering up to ten scholarships to first-time students at Mississippi State University in the form of no-cost housing for the first two semesters for students meeting selection requirements. The value of this scholarship is defined by the cost of living at a university dormitory which for two semesters beginning in 2005 would be as much as \$2,900. This scholarship is most unusual in that most scholarships pay only tuition and books; this one is only for housing. To receive this scholarship, applicants must reside in the house located on fraternity row, accept its standards, and pursue membership in FarmHouse. The facility was constructed in 1991 at a cost of more than \$500,000 with accommodations for 42 students and a resident house mother. Meal service is provided on an at-cost basis to residents. Recipients of this scholarship must make a minimum 2.5 GPA for their first semester in order to continue receiving the scholarship for the second semester of eligibility. Failure to obtain this minimum GPA will result in a reduction in value of the scholarship by 50% for the second semester.
