General Business Administration minor requires 12 hours must be at taken at the MSU main campus. This minor is attained by taking **seven** of the following courses: BL 2413, ACC 2013, ACC 2023, EC 2113, EC 2123, FIN 3123, MKT 3013, MGT 3114, BIS 3233, BQA 2113, and BQA 3123.

Choose MKT 4413 plus 4 more approved MKT courses to complete the Marketing minor. Check with advisor.

Transfer students must take at least 15 hours ATM courses at MSU plus internship. Transfer credits with grade of C or higher will be considered toward fulfillment of degree requirements.

Field trips are required with some classes and costs are in addition to fees and tuition. Charges for field trips are prorated to students based on actual cost of transportation plus meals and lodging when applicable.
