Note:

A student with an ACT score less than 21 or a subscore below 18 or an SAT of less than 860 must take Praxis I Pre-Professional Skills Tests (PPST) or Computer--Based Academic Skills Assessment Test (CBT) in reading, writing, and mathematics, and make designated cut score for each section.

Student must submit Admission to Teacher Education upon completion of the 45 hours with a 2.5 GPA in the General Education Core and a cumulative 2.5 G.P.A; professional Educ. courses cannot be taken until this is completed.

Note:

Complete application for Admission to Student Teaching by established deadline during semester before student teaching. Meet all published eligibility requirements including a 2.5 GPA in teaching field courses.

Register to take Praxis II: Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) and specialty area exam in Home Economics and submit a passing score in each as a requirement for graduation. Passage of exam must be completed for certification.

All HS courses must be completed with a grade of C or higher.

Transfer credits with a grade of C or better will be considered toward fulfillment of degree requirements.

Field trips are required with some classes and costs are in addition to fees and tuition. Charges for field trips are prorated to students based on actual cost of transportation plus meals and lodging when applicable.
