- Exactly three letters of support from faculty and/or administrative colleagues or superiors.**
- Exactly three letters of support from former students; two must have graduated within the last five years.**
- Teaching Vita (not to exceed five pages). Include those parts of a general vita that would pertain specifically to teaching, such as courses taught and developed, research and scholarship in teaching, and teaching awards.
- Nominee's statement of educational/teaching philosophy (not to exceed two pages).
- Description and evidence of teaching methods and assessment of student learning (not to exceed 10 pages).
- Three current course syllabi.
- A one to two page student evaluation summary table listing the means for each individual University evaluation question for each semester of each course taught and evaluated, noting course number, title or abbreviated title, and semester and year, for all courses taught over the past five years if applying for the Grisham award and three to five years if applying for one of the Alumni awards. Also, include copies of official statistical summaries for all courses taught and evaluated; however, do NOT include individual student response sheets.
