- A one-to-two-page student evaluation summary table listing the means for each additional University evaluation question for each semester of each course taught and evaluated, noting course number, title or abbreviated title, and semester and year, for all courses taught over the past five years if applying for the Grisham award and three to five years if applying for the Zacharias or Alumni awards. Also, include copies of official statistical summaries for all courses taught and evaluated.
